Footnotes

IDEALS AND DREAMS was up close, had a good position from the four path on the turn and with the lead in upper stretch fought gamely for the win. O B THE BEST was back early, moved up on the turn and from the five path through the stretch just missed. JENPEG dueled from the outside and had a bid from the three path at the top of the stretch but finished evenly on the rail. SENOR UNO was off the pace, moved up from the four path on the turn and from the six path through the stretch finished well. CLASSIC EXECUTIVE was in range and raced evenly on the turn but needed more through the stretch. BLONDESSILVERDREAM was in touch early and saved ground on the turn but lacked room in mid stretch. ROYAL EXPLOSIVE dueled from the inside and had a slim lead on the turn but tired in upper stretch. GIMMEA CAN DO IT dueled from between foes and was a factor on the turn but had nothing left. DELIGHTED SEASON had no speed and trailed the field on the turn while never a threat.
