JON SNOW was up close, roused from the inside on the turn, vied through the stretch and held sway. ABRUPTLY was off the pace, had a mild gain on the turn and closed willingly through the stretch. HARD GRAFT was well back, trailed the field on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch rallied belatedly. QUAKER SHAKER TONY stalked the leader, chased from the three path on the turn, was carried out to the six path at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. GLOBAL ICON was in mid pack, hustled along on the turn and with a bid at the top of the stretch needed more. AGAIN PLEASE set the pace, had the lead on the turn but drifted at the top of the stretch and faded late. NORTHOFFITY was in mid field, saved ground on the turn and failed to fire. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON NORTHOFFITY AGAINST JON SNOW AND QUAKER SHAKER TONY FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE BACKSTRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
