### Footnotes

HIGH PLATEAU set the pace, was headed on the far turn while in the three path, had the lead at the top of the stretch and was kept to task. WILDCAT PRINCE stalked the leaders from the outside, was a factor from the four path on the far turn and had a bid in upper stretch but was outfinished. MAVERICK MAN tracked the leader from the inside, forced the pace on the far turn and vied to mid stretch but leveled off late. NORTHERN MAGIC showed no speed and saved ground on the far turn but needed more. DOWN WITH DIXIE was unhurried early, dueled from between foes on the far turn but had nothing left.
