PINWINEE WHISKEY stalked the pacesetters from the inside then angled out, went between foes in the drive and rallied willingly for the win. WHEATON'S JOY kept contact with the leaders while off the rail on the turn, was in the 5-path for the stretch run and finished a good effort with a solid wide try. APPEALING CLASS off the early pace, got it going in the stretch run, caught fire late from the 4-path and was up for the show. A TWIST OF SHERREE vied for the lead after breaking sharply, pressed the pace to mid stretch then weakened. GO FLY A KITE hustled to the lead from the inside, vied through the turn then faded in the stretch run. DREAM FEVER came from off the pace to put in a non threatening late run. LADY'S A PISTOL saved ground and had no rally. SHELBY'S REQUEST was outside foes, off the pace and did not menace.
