Footnotes

ORIENTALSPRINGHOPE settled in the early going, was well back, closed ground on the turn while 5-wide into the stretch, then kept it going and was up in time to nip inside rival. MYSTERIOUS AFFAIR was in a speed battle and looking for the lead through the turn while between foes, gained it into deep stretch then was outdone late. DEVIL'S GOOD GIRL was close up throughout, backed off from between foes on the turn then came again with a good stretch try. ROMAN ROMANCE was hustled up on the outside of rivals to be four wide into the turn, dueled from there into the stretch then had nothing left late. CHERRY TREE HILL in striking distance on the turn, bid 4-wide into the stretch only to even out in the final furlong. NATIVE BRICK on the inside and in touch with the speed battle entering the turn, failed to stay close then lacked the needed stretch bid. CALL ME SUE had speed to take a brief lead, dueled inside of foes on the turn then gave way. GOLDEN ABERDEEN trailed and was not a factor.
