DUGALD had speed inside, dueled with foe on the turn and then was kept to task. WORKING MAN BLUES had speed, tracked the leader down the backstretch and was outgunned in the stretch drive. SPIRIT TO RUN was off the pace, three wide backstretch and then rallied up the inside for the show. AARON'S CLASSIC tracked leaders, chased three wide on the far turn and then ran evenly to the wire. REDEPLOY trailed early, passed tired foes in the stretch and was not a factor. HENNESSY MOON was in mid pack, put in a mild bid on the far turn and then faded through the stretch. ANOTHER ASCOT lost ground from mid field and trailed.
