TRAJECTORY LINE was unhurried early, roused from the three path on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch was up in time. PORTO RUSKAS was in touch, had a good position on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was outgunned. AVOID THE RUSH stumbled at the break, trailed the field, was hustled along on the turn and closed willingly through the stretch. GANTU was in range, raced evenly on the turn and from the five path through the stretch needed more. KINSHASA'S PARADIS pressed the leader, dueled from the outside on the turn and with the lead in upper stretch gave way. EXCHANGE NOTE was away alertly, set a pressured pace and vied in upper stretch but flattened out. FLEET STORM was off the pace and roused from the inside on the turn but failed to fire.
