TAGS AND TOWEL stalked the leader, was roused on the turn, a factor from the three path at the top of the stretch and proved best. TURN IT UP had no speed, was hustled along from the three path on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was not enough. CAYMAN PEACH set the pace, had a clear lead on the turn, was pressured at the top of the stretch and gave way. CENT T MINT trailed the field, moved up from the four path on the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch needed more. I SEE ROCKETS was in touch, saved ground on the turn but had no late kick. AFLEET'S LOVE SONG was up close, lost ground on the turn and had no impact. PRIMPING was in range, in tight into the turn and had no response. I AM GOLD was back early, trailed the field on the turn and failed to menace.
