GENERAL STAFF pressed the leader, was a factor on the turn and with the lead at the top of the stretch from the three path prevailed. GOLD ACCOUNT was unhurried early, was hustled along from the three path on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch rallied late. CAT N SASSY showed no speed, was roused from the inside on the turn and closed belatedly through the stretch. CHIEF NO TELL set a pressured pace, had a slim lead on the turn and vied through the stretch but gave way late. TEQUILA KILLS was in touch, chased on the turn and from the three path at the top of the stretch leveled off. BUCK CASH was off slowly, trailed the field on the turn and passed a tired rival. YAMANA was well back and showed nothing in a dull effort.
