VIKRANT dueled early, had the lead on the turn and with a clear lead through the stretch proved best. CALEDON CAT stalked the leaders, was a factor from the three path on the turn and was roused through the stretch but was no match for the winner. JAZZ BOY was in mid pack, hustled along from the three path on the turn and had a mild gain through the stretch. GRAY MESA was up close, closed the gap on the turn from the three path and from the five path at the top of the stretch needed more. GRAND ASSASSIN dueled early, chased from the inside on the turn and flattened out in the drive. ONE WAY CONNECTION was well back, trailed the field on the turn and passed tired foes through the stretch. CHARLIE O had no speed, showed little and had no impact. SEA PLEASURE was hustled early, raced evenly from the three path on the turn and backed away in the stretch. COMPADRE STRIKES was off the pace, trailed the field at the top of the stretch in a dull effort.
