Footnotes

BETTER THAN BITTER had early outside speed to vie briefly, shook clear on the turn, held sway to the wire and was kept to task. FOXS CONSORT on the inside through the turn, angled out, was in the 3-path for the drive, angled out and had a late surge to catch the place. TOUCH OF JAZZ vied from the inside of the winner early, chased that one through the turn then finished inside with no late kick. INQUISTIVE HOUSE broke awkwardly, was off the early pace then came home willingly with an outside stretch run. DONNA NOOK tracked the leader and kept in touch from off the rail on the turn then lacked a final bid. HASTY NOTE was off the pace and did not come up with a serious bid while finishing inside. COUSIN PAM was settled in the early going, rated off the pace and then failed to threaten.
