### Footnotes

MY NATALIE up on the pace, bid three wide going into the stretch then drew clear as much the best. TOMAHAWK GAP bobbed at the break, dueled from the rail and was in the mix into the stretch, could not go with the winner but ran on for the place. LOOKING FOR ACTION off the pace then in the three path into the stretch, angled out and rallied for the show spot. WEST COAST MISS between foes on the turn, tracked the leaders then lacked a strong stretch kick. LET'S GET TRASHY saved ground then lacked final rail bid. STOP THE BOMBING had a belated run but did not threaten the leaders at the wire. HAITIAN GOLD chased the speed duel while three wide on the turn then had no finish. DAINTY SECRET dueled outside and was in the battle into the stretch turn then faltered. DANCIN CHANCE four wide and in the hunt on the turn for home, tired. COGNAC MISS was off the pace and not a factor. ARGUIDOS trailed and was outdistanced.
