OLYMPIC ADVICE angled out and closed outside of foes on the far turn, bid 4-wide into the stretch and completed the strong rally. NIGHT EDITION was off the pace and trailing a tight group, moved between foes on the far turn, cut to the rail and rallied from there to finish well. LA BALLERINE had early speed to lead for a half, backed off between foes into the far turn then moved outside of foes into the stretch, came again and finished with good energy. SIMPLY PRECIOUS pressed the pace then bid off the rail and led on the far turn only to give way in the drive. HUNTINGTHETRUTH four wide early, kept close, bid and led into the stretch then weakened in the final furlong. EMILYNA stalked the leaders from the inside then lacked a rally. SPORTIVE SPIRIT pressed the early pace then backed away and faded.
