Footnotes

HOLY SCHNEIKIES showed speed, set the pace and with mild pressure on the far turn was kept to task through the stretch. COOK'S LOOK was off the pace, had a mild gain on the far turn, angled outside through the stretch and was up for place. IMITATION OF LIFE was in range and closed the gap on the far turn but from the five path through the stretch was all out. WORTH A PUNT stalked the leader and was a factor from the three path at the top of the stretch but gave way late. AEOLUS was off slow and hustled along on the far turn but had no late kick. NOT TOO TACKY was squeezed back at the start and raced evenly on the far turn but was not a factor. BANYAN COURT was off the pace and showed nothing while never a threat.
