**Footnotes**

GLENCREE was in range, roused on the turn and raced from the seven path at the top of the stretch but angled inside and proved best. APRIL HALO was in mid field, raced evenly from the inside on the turn and gained gradually through the stretch. ESSA'S LOVE was hustled from the inside, a factor on the turn and had the lead from the three path in upper stretch but drifted out through the lane. WILDA was up close and had a good position on the turn but from the seven path at the top of the stretch evened out. SOUTH BEACH ANNA had no speed and raced evenly from between foes on the turn but from the four path through the stretch had no late kick. L. T.'S GIRL was unhurried early, chased on the turn and from the five path through the stretch had no impact. BEEJAYKAY was in mid pack and saved ground on the turn in a dull effort. BEAR WHITE SOCKS was off the pace and had a mild gain from the four path on the turn but from the eight path through the stretch leveled off. JAMPERA was in touch early but trailed the field on the turn and was not a factor. BESTLA showed speed from the outside and had a slim lead from between foes on the turn but had nothing left through the stretch.
