**Footnotes**

VOLUNTAS closed four-wide into the turn, gained steadily, challenged at the 1/4 pole, dueled into the stretch then drove clear in the final furlong. CHRIS'S BAD BOY dueled three-deep, wore down rivals and was engaged by VOLUNTAS at the 1/4pole, dueled into the stretch and yielded with a furlong to run. INSINGER raced midpack between rivals, closed leaving the backstretch, moved to the rail and gained on the turn then rallied gamely between rivals in the stretch but failed to menace. SAINT RONALD dueled from the inside, yielded approaching the 1/4 pole then tired in the stretch. SWEETY'S BOY closed three-wide into the turn, gained gradually but failed to threaten. BLAZING MONSTER chased along the rail, was checked in tight quarters early turn, moved out between rivals at the top of the stretch but never reached contention. DECIMAL raced well off the pace, came four-wide out of the turn and failed to menace. JUST WES showed early foot, was joined in a duel, vied to the turn and gave way. WHEN YOUR GOOD broke alertly and was hustled at the front but could not make the pace, stalked to the top of the stretch and tired.
