ELI was in touch, gained ground on the turn, was a factor at the top of the stretch and was all out for the win. BUBBLE GUM SHRIMP was unhurried early, moved up from the three path on the turn and from the four path through the stretch had a good effort. NORTHOFTHEMOUNTAIN had no speed, was hustled along on the turn and from the three path through the stretch finished well. FERRY INN was in range and roused on the turn but lacked a late response. MOLINAROS PRIDE was hustled early and saved ground on the turn but had no impact. MORELON showed speed and set the pace but with a clear lead on the turn gave way through the stretch. DEMONOLIGY was up close early but chased from the inside on the turn and from the four path through the stretch was outrun. WHYS BEST GUY was well back, trailed the field and was never a threat.
