**Footnotes**

IN LOVE IN SEATTLE had speed and led into the turn, held sway from off the rail and then was kept to task in the run to the wire. TALK FAST in mid pack, gained from the inside, bid up the rail in the drive and finished off a good effort. SERAPHINA QUEEN off the early pace then five wide on the turn, rallied from there and finished willingly. PRETTY PESO came from off the pace to put in a mild stretch rail rally. PARISIAN JADE had belated off the rail run to no avail. UP AGAINST IT close up, tracked the leader on the turn then had no finish. JUST LIKE PERRY chased the speed and was in the game into mid stretch then tired between foes. STILL SHARP had a wide trip into the turn while chasing the speed then evened out. FASTER THAN A JET well back then wide into the stretch, lacked the needed bid. TAGS AND TOWEL backed off early then was not a factor. BRACE YASELSHEILA chased from between foes then lost ground and faded.
