Footnotes

CATCH THE POSSE stalked the early leaders, had a slim lead on the far turn and from the three path through the stretch was kept to task. CANT BE PETE was well back, moved up from the three path on the far turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch was up for place. POINT TUPPER was in mid pack, a factor from the inside on the far turn and vied through the stretch but was outfinished. WIN AND REIGN showed speed, raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but from the three path at the top of the stretch needed more. DEPUTY LOR was off the pace and roused on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch had no response. EXCALIBUR was off slow, hustled to the lead and led on the backstretch but was empty on the far turn.
