Footnotes

KINNABARI was well back and trailed the field on the turn but from the seven path through the stretch rallied to get up in time. CANADIANNE WHISKEY was in range, hustled along on the turn and had the lead in mid stretch but was caught at the wire. BEEJAYKAY was back early, had a mild gain on the turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was up for show. GOREWAY PRIDE duled from the outside and had a slim lead from the four path at the top of the stretch but weakened late. GOLD TORY was unhurried early, gained ground from the four path on the turn but from the five path through the stretch was all out. SALANDER was in touch and raced evenly on the turn but lacked a late response. MAGGIE FITZ was off the pace and moved up from the three path on the turn but from the four path through the stretch leveled off. BIG OAK LADY broke awkwardly and saved ground on the turn but had no impact. MOLINARO SECRETO was hustled early and had a slim lead on the turn but tired in mid stretch. BESTLA showed speed from between foes but chased on the turn and came up empty.
