## **Footnotes**

MI QUERIDO set the pace, had a clear lead in hand on the turn and widened through the stretch under light handling. CATERINAMARIA was in mid pack, moved up on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch closed willingly. DIXIE JET was squeezed at the start, roused from the inside on the turn and rallied from last. TEQUILA showed no speed, had a mild gain on the turn, angled out in the stretch and closed. WITH ALL DILIGENCE was off slowly, raced evenly from the three path on the turn and closed willingly through the stretch. HOT SUMMER WIND was off the pace, raced in hand from the four path on the turn and from the six path at the top of the stretch had no kick. PRIMPING was in touch and gained ground on the turn but flattened out in the stretch. CONSOLIDATOR GAL stalked the leader, chased hard on the turn and gave way through the stretch. PROWL was hustled early and saved ground on the turn but faded in the stretch. COMPADRE'S REBEL veered in at the break, was roused from the inside on the turn and had no response. DELILAH'S RING was well back, showed nothing and was never in contention. PURPLE WIND was in range and broke down into the turn. A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE RUN INTO THE TURN LEFT THE RESULTS AS POSTED.
