AYENDA was off a step a slow, moved up on the far turn and from the three path through the stretch proved best. NUMANS LADY was in touch, a factor from the inside on the far turn and finished well through the stretch. PERFECT SUSPECT was in range, raced evenly from the three path on the far turn and from the six path through the stretch finished willingly. SUZANS SPIRIT was off the pace and had a mild gain from the four path on the far turn but from the six path through the stretch was all out. HIT BY A HURRICANE set the pace, was pressured on the far turn and vied in upper stretch but weakened late. ROSE DREAMS had no speed and gained ground from the three path on the far turn but from the four path through the stretch faded. DAN'S LAST KNIGHT was off a step slow and trailed the field on the far turn while outrun. TRAJECTORY ROSE stalked the early leader but lost ground on the far turn and had nothing left.
