**Footnotes**

FYNBOS in touch, closed and bid from the rail turning for home then drew off as much the best. STONERUN in mid field then wide turning for home, angled in for the drive, finished inside and was going well at the wire. HAZOR pressed from the inside, led from off the rail on the turn then was outfinished in the drive. ITS IN THE BLOOD never far back from mid pack, was in the 6-path for the stretch bid then finished off a good effort. LA VITESSE stalked the leaders then bid from off the rail while 3-wide turning for home then evened out. VICTORIAN DAMASK was off the pace and did not fire. ORO CALIENTE was off the pace from mid field and never a threat. FEELING NAUGHTY was well back and lacked interest. HEYHOWHATDOYOUKNOW was bumped at the break and then raced off the pace. ROYAL DILEMMA had speed to be a factor for a half then faded.
