MISS SILVER BULETT was away alertly, a factor from the three path on the turn, raced from the four path at the top of the stretch and drew off while drifting to the rail. WONDERFUL CAVELLE showed no speed, had a mild gain on the turn and from the four path through the stretch finished well. SWEEPING FRONT set the pace and dueled from the inside on the turn but ducked out mid stretch. REBEL GRAY was in touch and had a good inside position on the turn but lacked a late response. WILLOWY WENDY was in mid pack and raced evenly on the turn but from the four path through the stretch had no impact. FRANKS GIRL forced the pace and dueled from the outside on the turn but tired in mid stretch. SILVER FEELING was off slow and hustled along on the turn but from the six path at the top of the stretch had no response. SISTER GAIL was off the pace, trailed the field and from the five path at the top of the stretch had a dull effort.
