Footnotes

NEAR EXPECTATIONS tracked the leaders then closed and bid 3-wide in the drive, took command and was kept to task. SECOND CUP came from off the pace to outside and coming on through the stretch, finished well but could not reach the winner. BUBBLE WRAPPED well back in the early going, gained on the turn then put in a wide stretch rally to finish with good energy but not in time. IT'SAPOSSIBILITY up on the pace then bidding three wide on the turn, stayed in the hunt into deep stretch but evened out late. QUINTANA hustled to the lead, was battling inside on the turn and into the stretch then gave way in the final furlong. AGAIN PLEASE had a mild gain after racing in mid field but it was not enough. MOONSHINE AMOUR in touch early, backed off the speed trio and then tired. BITING HUMOUR raced off the pace and was never a factor. LLEWELLYN forced the pace for a half then faltered and was all done.
