Footnotes

HARDROAD TO HEAVEN well back and then still trailing into the far turn, bid inside and came home with a strong rail drive to prove best. MISHMASH was off slow, made up ground and swung wide for the drive, then came home with a six wide try in a solid effort. PERSONAL SIGNAL kept in touch throughout then bid between foes in the drive and finished off a good try. PAUL BUNYAN came from off the pace to bid in the drive and finished with good energy between foes. BORREGO ROAD up on the pace, duelled on the far turn then gave way to rivals in the late going. DON'TPUSHMEAROUND was an early factor, vied on the far turn and into the stretch then faltered. PEACH OF A DAY stayed a factor into the stretch turn then lacked a finish. OH BOY rated in mid field then failed to fire when the serious running began. DEVILWOOD tracked the leaders from off the rail into the far turn then tired. ROYAL FUGITIVE raced well back and was not a threat. NORDIC DANCER had early speed to lead the field, backed off into the far turn and faded.
