Footnotes

WORTH A PUNT set the pace, had a clear lead on the far turn, took command at the top of the stretch and was impressive. CAN'T BE PETE had no speed, gained ground on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch was up for place. KINNAIRD was well back, moved up on the far turn and from the four path at the top of the stretch passed tired foes. NORTE AND NICE was in range and raced evenly from the inside on the far turn but lacked a rally. MAKAAAN was in mid pack and had a mild gain from the inside on the far turn but tired in upper stretch. CATCH THE POSSE stalked the leader but chased on the far turn and came up empty. POINT TUPPER was unhurried, trailed the field on the far turn and failed to fire.
