ETERNALLY YOURS stalked the pace, closed three-wide late turn, gained command midstretch and held T.J. MAGIC safe under a drive. T. J. MAGIC was well back early on the rail, closed on the turn, bid between rivals midstretch, dueled to the wire and missed. ROMAN ROMANCE was well back on the second path early, hustled three-wide on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. PROSPECT'S DELIGHT showed speed sprinted clear early, set a pressured pace to midstretch and yielded. WISE ENDING was close early between rivals, fell back on the turn, raced three-wide and was all out in the stretch. FLYING TABRIZ pressed the pace from the rail but tired at the top of the stretch. MAMA'S DINNER pressed early four-wide, bid midturn but failed to match strides, pressed the leader to the top of the stretch and tired.
