### Footnotes

BRONSON moved quickly between rivals on the clubhouse turn to gain position, stalked the leader in hand, was asked to close on the far turn and challenged midturn, dueled to the end and outfinished YATSKO. YATSKO led quickly, set a reserved pace, quickened on the far turn but was joined midturn, dueled to the end and missed. GOOD COMPANY stalked the pace from the rail, was roused at the top of the stretch and was all out at the finish. CLASSIC CALLER stalked from the third path, was roused at the top of the stretch was empty. WINTER ESCAPE was well back early, closed between rivals into the far turn,tired approaching the stretch and finished on the rail. CHIMES REBEL rated well off the pace then lacked a rally. GRIND was unhurried and trailed to the top of the stretch then passed a tiring rival. INDIGENE was in range along the rail early but faded steadily beginning on the backstretch.
