PRINCESS RYAN was unhurried in the early going, edged up to attend the pace after a half mile, then dueled with the leader to the final turn and pulled clear. IRISH LION HEART tracked the leaders from the outside, edged closer on the final turn and closed willingly. THAI CHEAU lagged early, inched up two wide on the final turn and responded through the stretch under strong urging. NAT THE BRAT was slow into stride, mounted a wide rally and closed with interest but much too late. HAPPYHOOFERTOOS edged to the front early, set all the pace to the final turn, then weakened. LOW EXPECTATIONS showed little. I OWE UME raced wide through the first turn and did not reach contention. FAIR TECHNOLOGY had no speed.
