Footnotes

WHITE MARK broke alertly, allowed to settle, inched up on the leaders, found his best stride turning for home and offered a strong closing kick to be just up in the final stride. BEAU BRYAN took command the first time through the backstretch, set all the fractions, dug in for the final assault but could not hold off the winner in the final stride. CRESCO PRIME TIME rushed up to chase the front runners, was checked slightly into the first turn without losing much ground, remained in contention to the late going and closed evenly without menacing the outcome. ZAL'S PAL was pushed out to the outside fence through the first turn, recovered, inched up on the leaders while saving ground and closed willingly on the inside but much to late in a very game effort. CORPORATECONNECTION was slow into stride, raced in the middle of the pack throughout, attempted to rally in the final turn but had little response when asked. MARINE MIKE raced rankly into the first turn, pushed rivals out very wide and did not rally. SAILOR MORAN was forced out wide through the first turn and did not recover while racing wide the rest of the way. PERSIAN REVENGE showed brief speed and dropped back quickly.
