ALABAMA BOY was unhurried early, saved ground on both turns, crept up, split rivals, pulled away late while being well handled. WARREN'S HOT STUFF was never far back, had a brief lead late but was outfinished. JOLLY OLLIE lagged from the start, was very wide throughout and showed some late interest. DIVORCE ATTORNEY raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground but could not rally. SWISS ALPINE broke the quickest, set pace to final turn and came up empty. CUSTOM CONTINENTAL did not reach contention.
