TRAINSPOTTING dueled with SWISS ALPINE to the final turn, put that one away and gradually pulled clear as much the best while being kept to task. HANGER THIRTYEIGHT raced unhurriedly and far back to the second turn, bid three wide and closed willingly without menacing the winner. SWISS ALPINE rushed to the lead before the first turn, contentiously dueled with the winner to the final turn and gradually gave way. TUDOR BLUE raced very wide through both turns and had no impact on the outcome. INVESTMENT GRADE lagged and show little. WARREN'S PRANCER broke the quickest, dropped back, chased the leaders to the final turn and gave way.
