POKER DAVE saved ground to second turn, shifted out to rally willingly but could not reach the front one. BEN'S STARRY NIGHT broke the best, showed good speed to the backstretch and weakened. TUDOR BLUE gradually moved forward, but could not reach the front ones. CATCH CODY broke slowly and did not reach contention. MINISTER MACHINE broke in the air, immediately rushed up, remained close to the final turn and gave out. MAHMOUD MEMORY bore out badly on the first turn and remained well back the rest of the way.
