VEGAS THIEF was fractious in the gate, edged up through the backstretch, rallied five wide, dug in late and just held. JANS GOLD broke awkwardly, inched up to the final turn, bid four wide then wide turning for home and rallied strong but ran out of ground. GOOD AS IT GETS off a step slow and bothered by JANS GOLD moved forward on the inside, was closing well but flattened slightly in the final strides. MARK THE COP rushed to the front before the first turn, set the pace to late in the final turn but came up empty when it counted. INVESTMENT GRADE tracked on the outside to the second turn and had little response when asked. SLICKEST was never a factor. GO DADDY O broke alertly, shifted in, had no speed and showed little.
