SEAFIRE tracked the leaders from the inside for a half mile, responded when asked on the backstretch, cut the corner, dug in gamely and was up in time. DIRECT CONNECT lagged to the final turn, bid four wide, shifted in for the drive but could not reach the winner. WATCH ME GO BYEBYE sped to and open lead the first time through the backstretch, was joined by I'LL TRY, turned that one back then weakened in deep stretch. I'LL TRY rushed up on the outside to join the leader the first time through the backstretch, remained close to the furlong pole and gave out. MARK TREY was allowed to settle but had little response when asked. IM PURE COUNTRY attended the pace for a quarter mile but could not keep up. CIRCLETHEWINNER had no speed was eased and walked off.
