MOMMY GO TOO broke alertly, dueled with SCHERANDERO four wide for a half mile and kicked clear to win going away. PENNY'S IMAGE edged up three wide to bid on the final turn but could not reach the top one. JANS DYNASTY trailed far back for a half mile and rallied mildly on the outside. SMART BLUES dueled early, dropped back and chased the top ones the rest of the way. OH ME OH MY broke awkwardly, lagged and then showed some late interest without impacting the outcome. LOUIS WHO was off a step slow, shifted out for racing room but had little response when needed. GOODDAYTOGOFLYIN raced very wide and showed little. SCHERANDERO sped to the front, cornered wide, dueled for a half mile and stopped.
