Footnotes

MON IN THE MOON race unhurriedly along the inside to the final turn, bid five wide, quickly closed the gap and blew by everyone in the late going. SHADY MARKET chased the leaders for three quarters of a mile, edged up to loom dangerously while three wide on the final turn, assumed a short lead in the stretch but could not hold off MON IN THE MOON in the final yards. MANDERLEY BAY attended the pace from the inside to the furlong pole, challenged the front end but flattened just when more effort was needed. BROUGHT TO JUSTICE raced far back to the stretch, came four wide through the final turn and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. RIVER SLANEY sped immediately to the front, set all the pace to the final furlong and came up empty. FANCY SUMMER hopped out of the gate, recovered immediately,sprinted to prompt the pace for three quarters of a mile, then stopped quickly in the lane.
