FALLING KNIFE raced unhurriedly for a mile, bid outside, took command into the final turn and pulled away as much the best. MISSISSIPPI GOLD raced in the middle of the pack for a mile, edged forward and closed willingly, while no match for the winner was clearly second best. STEEL BLUE was never far back but could not match strides with the top two and closed evenly. NORTHERN INDY assumed a short lead after a half mile and gradually dropped back. WEGNER was never a factor. GOLD COAST STRIKER raced in the middle of the field for a mile and gave way. AUTISM AWAKENESS was far back and eased after a mile then walked off. NORVILLE was eased after a half mile and walked off.
