ROYAL MADAME raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the solo leader, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, edged clear outside the furlong marker and drew away while ridden out. NANA KNOWS raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while off the rail on the turn, advanced three wide into the stretch, was put to a drive on the outside and earned the place while no match for the winner. BEVERLY BELLE became rank when BERNICE SPECIAL drifted out in front of him early, was rated on the inside, came under some urging on the far turn, moved off the rail at the top of the stretch, shifted further to the outside once straightened for the drive and lacked the needed response while clear for the show. SURPRISE SQUALL was in tight between rivals nearing the first turn, lingered well back in the field, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. COCO'S SHADOW steadied off heels nearing the first turn, swerved five wide into the turn, dropped to three wide late on that turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, dropped in a tad entering the stretch and failed to rally. BERNICE SPECIAL came out in the early going, set the pace while off the rail, was challenged at the top of the stretch, vied past the three-sixteenths pole then gave way. ALL HER DUE went four wide on the first turn, raced towards the front while on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and came up empty. DAY GIRL was in tight nearing the first turn, settled towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and was no factor. (Rail at 20 Feet)
