PRATT STREET bumped with a rival at the start, dropped to the inside midway through the first turn, was rated on the inside, waited behind the leaders from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter-pole, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, took the lead in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and drew clear under steady urging. TITO raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, contested the pace between rivals, dropped back a bit inside the five-eighths pole, was urged along while two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and was second best. STONEMASON raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. STEADY ROAR raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came under some urging while two to three wide on the far turn and had nothing left. SMART MASTERPIECE raced near the inside on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went three then four wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. REFUND STATUS bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace, vied inside on the far turn and gave way. WHY SEVENTEEN went three to four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, raced four then five wide on the far turn and was no factor. KIT'S HALO raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, contested the pace, vied into the stretch and capitulated.
