SPANISH EMPIRE forwardly placed three wide early, moved up to split the leaders down the backstretch, gained the edge around the second turn, drifted to the rail when clear and then held on. TENPINS vied for the lead under restraint early, was headed around the second turn, dropped back a bit turning for home, eased out to rally but could not overtake the top one. COMIC TRUTH settled off the rail, ranged up approaching the drive and then hung. KODEMA bumped by ROAR OF THE TIGER at the break, eased to the rail while in hand, advanced around the second turn, moved out in upper stretch and then had no final kick. ROAR OF THE TIGER veered into KODEMA leaving the gate, raced in the back early and was no real threat. SEAINSKY off last, crossed to the inside to settle, swung out for the drive and was not a threat. FITZROYAL vied outside TENPINS early, got out sprinted nearing the second turn and then faded.
