Footnotes

SILENT SPIN showed good speed and pressed the pace on the inside, was taken back off the pace skirmish leaving the backstretch, moved off the inside on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, shifted out over heels inside the quarter-pole, accelerated to the lead passing the three-sixteenths pole, kicked clear into the final furlong and held well under steady urging. HUNT FOR COLLEEN was bumped at the start then slow into stride, raced well back in the field, moved in nearing the half-mile pole, raced inside into the turn, shifted three wide near the three-eighths pole, moved to four wide outside the quarter-pole, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied on the far outside while under right hand urging and finished well to get the place. WIN FOR SUSAN was ridden along while just off the pace, moved closer near the half-mile pole, dropped back a bit and shifted three wide leaving the backstretch, chased three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened while able to get the show. SIPPERS bumped with a rival at the start, lacked

early speed, raced three then two wide on the turn and improved position. U KNOW WHAT I LIKE was ridden along while well off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. MOLLYS MISSB'HAVIN bumped with rivals at the start, showed good speed and pressed the pace between horses, bumped with foes on both sides leaving the backstretch, vied three then two wide on the turn, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch and tired. TUPELO HONEY bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace on the outside, jostled with MILLIE'S THUNDER leaving the backstretch, vied five then four wide on the turn, led into the stretch, lost the lead near the three-sixteenths-pole and gave way. LITTLEBITBLEST bumped with a rival at the start, showed no early speed, raced off the rail early on the turn, was carried four wide near the three-eighths pole, dropped back to one off the rail shortly thereafter and was no factor. HUGHES YOUR MOMMA brushed with a rival at the start, showed good speed, contested the pace while off the inside, bumped with MOLLYS MISSB'HAVIN leaving the backstretch, dropped to the inside on the turn, battled into the stretch and capitulated. MILLIE'S THUNDER brushed with a rival at the start, showed good speed and contested the pace, bumped with rivals on both sides leaving the backstretch, dropped back while three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and stopped.
