Footnotes

LYD RIVER showed good speed then was well placed on the inside, waited patiently behind the leaders on the turn, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, closed well to gain the lead near the furlong marker, inched clear shortly thereafter and prevailed under right hand urging. DEADLY CATCH brushed with a rival after the start, settled on the outside, moved closer while three then four wide on the turn, was asked to pick it up near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied into the stretch, closed well to make a bid passing the three-sixteenths pole, battled with LYD RIVER in the final furlong and was outfinished while clear for the place. YUKON BANDIT settled at the back of the field, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, moved further out inside the three-sixteenths pole, came under a strong drive and finished willingly for the show. NATAWAKI was urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and lacked the needed response. NO RULES NOW brushed with a rival after the start, was ridden along while off the pace, dropped to the inside midway through the turn and failed to rally. FIFTY ACRES contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn and tired. CUPID'S HIT contested the pace on the inside of FIFTY ACRES, vied off the rail on the turn and gave way.
