LAKENHEATH forwardly placed while three wide, bid in upper stretch, took over a furlong out and proved best under strong handling. BALA settled along the inside, eased out turning for home, angled out inside the furlong marker then was outfinished. TOOK OUT trailed until before the drive, rallied along the rail for the drive, eased out to split foes then did not have enough late. PRETTY GALE set the pace until nearing the drive and tired. WARREN'S WHISTLE raced wide and was outrun. SWINGING GATE stalked PRETTY GALE down the backstretch, gained the edge around the second turn and then gave way.
