FUTURE DIRECTION raced three wide into the first turn then dropped in, contested the pace on the inside of A BIT STORMY, vied near the inside on the far turn, inched clear at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive, maintained the lead into the final furlong and held sway under strong urging. BIRD STORM bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn, came under vigorous urging in upper stretch, continue to chase the winner in the final furlong and missed. ITSALLBOUTTHECHASE raced four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer while four to five wide on the far turn, chased outside in the stretch and finished willingly for the show. PETEADORIS raced five wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, lingered well back in the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and improved position. SOME KINDA TROUBLE raced six then five wide on the first turn, settled towards the

rear, was ridden along while four to five wide on the far turn and also improved position. MR. EXPLOITER bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. DEVIL'S APPRENTICE was caught five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was hard ridden while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. LAST CALL settled on the inside, came under a ride on the far turn and also failed to respond. A BIT STORMY raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped in, contested the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the far turn and tired. WIRE ME MY LOVE was caught seven wide early on the initial turn then dropped to five wide, lagged at the rear and showed little. B L'S PAPA COO COO was bumped on both sides at the start, dropped to the inside on the first turn, was rated in the front half of the field, came under urging while inside on the far turn and faded. GOLDEN VERSE raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came under urging with a half-mile to turn, went three then four wide on the far turn and dropped out.
