## Footnotes

BY APPOINTMENT disputed the pace on the inside, inched clear while under urging on the turn, came under a left-handed whip when challenged in upper stretch, battled with the runner-up into the final sixteenth, shook off that rival at that point and proved best under continued left-hand urging. WAR CHANCELOR chased the pace, raced inside early on the turn, came off the rail before the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while well clear for the place. BE A CHEROKEE unseated the rider and got loose during the post parade, ran off for about a quarter-mile before being caught by an outrider, was deemed fit to run by the state veterinarian, contested the pace between rivals, chased off the rail on the turn, pursued the leader under the whip in upper stretch and tired while clear for the show. OFFICER JOHN broke out then was corrected with a tug of the left rein, was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to rally. RETALIATOR was urged along while off the pace, dropped further back leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to three to four wide on the turn and weakened. DAT PUNCH showed no speed while hard ridden, went two to three wide on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and was no factor. LITTLE COMANCHE was ridden along on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
