AMICA was taken in hand nearing the first turn, raced behind rivals while under restraint on the opening bend, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, was put to the whip near the five-sixteenths, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, gained on the leader coming to the sixteenth-pole, battled with the runner-up late and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. IRISH VIXEN was last away, lagged at the rear while off the inside, was urged along early on the far turn, shifted three wide near the five-sixteenths pole then four wide shortly thereafter, swung six wide into the stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong, gained ground alongside the winner into the final sixteenth, battled with that rival late and just missed in a good effort. A NOBLE CALLING moved up while three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, inched clear leaving the backstretch, dropped to the inside near the three-eighths-pole, extended the advantage when set down in upper stretch, remained clear into the final furlong, was collared near the sixteenth-pole and weakened while able to get the show. MANKI raced just off the pace while off the inside, chased three then two wide on the far turn, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong and tired. THUNDER BONNET raced inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, bided her time while off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and weakened. ENDLESS RULES went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased four then three wide on the far turn, was put to the whip near the five-sixteenths and came up empty. DESERT OUTLAW contested the pace on the inside of a rival, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside on the far turn and gave way. SECOND LANGUAGE went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, dropped back while three to four wide on the

far turn and faltered.
