NATURALLY WILD lugged in bumping with PEACE RIVER LADY after the start, was straightened, raced close up while off the rail, bid for the lead nearing mid stretch, gained the lead and proved clearly best. DISTANT VALLEY (GB) stalked SOCCORY from early on, gave way grudgingly and was game for second. GOLDEN ANTIGUA lunged at the break, was bothered when PEACE RIVER LADY came in, saved ground while unhurried, split foes and rallied late. VERY GERI raced inside while devoid speed, eased out once turning for home, moved back to the rail inside the final furlong and tried hard. PEACE RIVER LADY hopped at the break, was forced in by NATURALLY WILD just after to bother GOLDEN ANTIGUA, recovered to be reserved, loomed a threat outside and had no final kick. TWILITE TRYST was outrun. SOCCORY set the pace until nearing the drive and gave way. CALMA PRADO tired.
