COACH GRAVY restrained three wide early, bid outside ATLANTIC SLICK approaching the second turn, got clear late and then held on. RABBIT TRACKS three wide around both turns, rallied gamely but was too late. ATLANTIC SLICK set the pace to mid stretch, then saved the show. CHARLIE TRUMPER between foes early, came inside around the second turn, eased out and lacked a finish. CHANGING STORM inside to the second turn, angled out to rally, then could make little impact. GUNNISLAKE moved to the inside going to the first turn, eased out around the second turn and came widest in the drive. DESERT FOX was outrun. PLAYON PLAYER hesitated at the break and was not a factor. BEARS EARS forced the pace for a half, then retreated. MARCH WEST settled off the rail, loomed around the second turn, then stopped.
